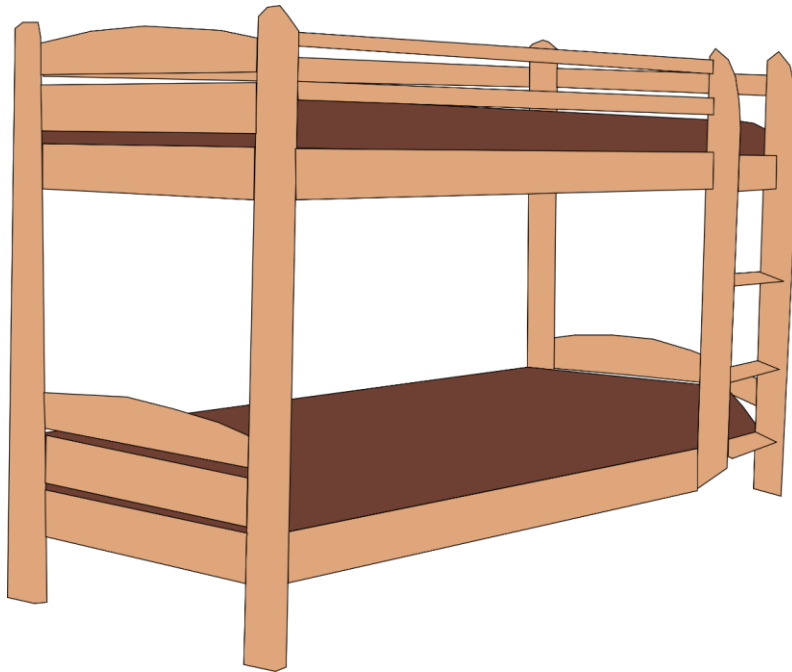
Where will we be staying?
